**COMPLETE THE CGU ADMISSIONS APPLICATION**

**APPLICATION FEE**  
The \$80 application fee is non-refundable. For a limited time, this fee will be waived.

**OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS**  
You may upload unofficial transcript PDF files to your application. Official transcripts should be sent to the CGU Office of Admissions.

**RESUME**  
You must submit a copy of your resume.

**STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**  
Please submit a 2-3 page statement of purpose that details your academic and/or professional achievements, your specific areas of interest within your desired field of study, why you are a strong candidate for graduate studies at CGU, and your career goals.

**LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION**  
Academic references from faculty who can speak to your academic ability are preferred; If you have substantial work experience, you may submit professional references.

**GRE/GMAT**  
Applicants to the MSEVAL program should submit GRE or GMAT scores. Applicants seeking to waive the test requirement can apply for a waiver based on professional experience and/or academic background. For information on applying for a waiver, please contact our enrollment team at [onlineadmissions@cgu.edu](mailto:onlineadmissions@cgu.edu) or (844) 675-8605.

Applicants to the MSIST program are not required to submit GRE or GMAT scores; however, applicants who have taken either are encouraged to upload scores that might enhance their application.
